

# Lesson Plan

**Subject:** Cardinal Directions (North, South, East, West, etc.)

**Grades:** Beginner - low level English learners

**Description:** Students will learn how to use cardinal directions in English to explain the location of various buildings and objects.

**Keywords:** north, south, east, west, northwest, northeast, southwest, southeast, cafe, pond, car, hospital, forest, fire station, police station, bank

**Materials needed:** video player, student handout, flashcards, science project materials (see the student handout)

**The Lesson:** Students will watch the lesson video while the teacher guides them. The teacher will then use the flash cards to review the contents with students. After that, the students will do a science project from the student handout. Lastly, the students and the teacher can do a final activity with the compass made during the science project.

## Final Activity suggestions:

1. The teacher can ask students where a particular object is located in the classroom. The students can use their cardinal directions knowledge and compasses to give correct answers in English.
2. Students can go outside and take pictures of different objects. Students then share their pictures with the other students. The other students must answer where that object is using English cardinal directions.
